#### **School Uniform**

At St Edmund's we believe that school uniform is important. A smart and distinctive uniform contributes to the public image of our school and our children are always easily identifiable. By taking a pride in their appearance, children are encouraged to take pride in other aspects of school life, including their work and surroundings.

It is expected that all children wear the uniform detailed below. It is expected that parents will name all of their child's belongings and items of clothing.

#### **Winter Uniform**

Children wear winter uniform from Autumn half term until the Easter holidays, although children may choose to wear winter uniform from September.

Boys School jumper Girls School jumper/cardigan

Plain white collared shirt Plain white collared shirt

School tie School tie

Grey shorts/trousers Royal blue skirt/pinafore

Grey or black socks Royal/ navy or white tights or white socks

Black school shoes Black school shoes

#### **Summer Uniform**

Children wear summer uniform for the Summer Term, from the Easter holidays. They may choose to wear summer uniform for the first half of the Autumn Term, but must change to winter uniform following the half term holiday.

**Boys** School jumper Girls School jumper/cardigan

Plain white collared shirt

School tie

Blue and white stripped dress

White ankle/knee length socks

Grey shorts/trousers

Grey or black socks

Black school shoes/closed toe sandals
School skirt/white revere collar blouse

Black school shoes (Y6 only)

### PE Kit

Children are required to change into the following kit during PE lessons:

Royal Blue shorts

School Gold T shirt

Black plimsolls (inside use)

Royal blue sweatshirt (optional)

Navy blue track suit bottoms

Trainers (outside use)

School track suit (optional but should be worn if representing the school)

For swimming:

Plain swimsuit/trunks

Swimming cap

# Outer Wear

Children wear dark coloured coats. Parents are also able to purchase a royal blue school fleece or a royal blue winter coat which is for outdoor wear only.

Children are strongly encouraged to wear caps during hot weather as protection from the sun. If children choose to wear a cap in summer or a hat in winter, these must be school caps and hats only.

#### **Jewellery, Hair and Accessories**

Children are permitted to wear a watch and small stud earrings. Children will be asked to remove other items as no other jewellery is permitted, unless worn for religious reasons. For safety reasons, children will also be asked to remove their watch during Physical Education lessons.

Long hair, which is below collar length or falls in front of the eyes, is worn tied back with a suitable band or clip. Excessively large or brightly coloured hair accessories are not permitted – they should be small, functional and in school or neutral colours. Parents are asked not to have designs shaved into children's hair during term time. Hair colour should be children's natural colour.

A school rucksack, book bag and PE bag are also available as optional items. <u>The rucksack is for junior children only.</u>
