EXPECTATIONS for the week in English, Maths and Science

- At least 3 maths activities (*from Education City*)
- At least 3 English activities (*from Education City*)
- At least 3 Science activities (*from Education City*)

DAILY READING/PHONICS/SPELLING/HANDWRITING

- Read for 10 minutes every day (e-books can be found at <https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/reading/> once you set up a free account)
- Read **5 alien words** and **5 real words each day** from the Phonics booklet. Remember to encourage them to spot the digraphs, split digraphs and trigraphs as you have been doing all year with their reading.
- Focus on spellings from the 100 HFW found in the children's journals
- **10 minutes of handwriting daily** – please watch your child carefully to ensure that they are forming the letters correctly and are starting on the line. Some children have picked up bad habits when forming letters which need to be corrected and can only be done so with adult support. Please see the school website for the 'letter formation' rhymes and 'letter formation' powerpoint.

RE project about Holy Week, focusing on Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Like the Senses Science project completed a few weeks ago, this could take the form of a poster, 3D model, or booklet.
