English

This week, as a school, we are focusing on writing. For this, we would like you like to create your own book. It can be any genre (fiction, non-fiction, poetry etc.) but must be of high quality. It can be completed on the computer or it can be hand written. For the book you must also consider if it needs a glossary, index, contents page or any other appropriate feature. Each book should have a beautifully designed front cover, which is appropriate to the text, and a relevant synopsis at the back. If you are happy to, send us a photo or email with details of your wonderful book.

Maths

Year 4's focus at the moment is time. We have looked at analogue time, 12 hour digital time and 24 hour digital time. It would be beneficial if the children could make, or draw, a teaching clock (like the one below) to show an understanding of the different parts of telling the time.

We would also like the children to create a timetable of their everyday activities and record the time that they do those activities using analogue time, 12 hour digital and 24 hour digital time. An example of this is shown below.

Example Timetable

Monday

Breakfast – Half past 8, 8:30am, 08:30
Start Work – 9 o'clock, 9:00am, 09:00
Stop Work – 3 o'clock, 3:00pm, 15:00
(You will add in more things than this)

- On top of the maths activities above, the children should be learning ALL their multiplication tables.

The children will present these on their return to school. **This project will continue for one more week.**
