Login in to Charanga and go to your YUMU assignments.

Click on "Listen and Appraise" and listen to the song "Jai Ho" (meaning "may victory be yours"). You can click on the "questions" button and answer some of the questions after you have listened to the song.

This song was written for a film called "Slumdog Millionaire" and is a musical style called Bhangra. Bhangra is a type of popular music combining Punjabi and Indian traditional music with Western pop music. It developed in Britain in the 1980s from people that had moved from Pakistan and India. Today Bhangra exists in different styles across the world, it fuses its sounds with hip-hop and R&B. Click on the "about the song" button if you want to find out more about this song. Now click on the "Warm-up Games". Go to Challenge 4. Only clap back when you are asked to.
