Login in to Charanga and go to your YUMU assignments.

Click on "Listen and Appraise" and listen to the song "Lord of the Dance" You can click on the "questions" button and answer some of the questions after you have listened to the song.

Lord of the Dance is from an Irish musical and dance production Riverdance, created by Michael Flatley in 1994. The show uses traditional Irish stepdancing and tells the story of Irish culture and the Irish immigration to America. Click on the "about the song" button if you want to find out more about this song. You can also watch a video performance of the song below.

Now click on the "Warm-up Games". Go to Challenge 5. Only clap back when you are asked to.

Next, click on "Flexible Games Track - In the Groove: Folk" - Gold Challenge. Click on Rhythm Grid, then Settings and choose Preset 1, 2 or 3. Play and clap along with the Rhythm. Try using the other controls and see what changes.

Lastly, click on "In the Groove - Folk: Learn to sing the song" and keep singing along to the song. Find different ways of moving to the pulse of the music.

Extension

Click on the "Compose with the song-In the groove: Folk" and create a composition using the notes on the side. Try and use more than the three notes from last week and then playback. In the settings button on the left you can adjust the playback speed and play along with a tuned instrument if you have access to one. Try changing notes and see what you can create!
