Login in to Charanga and go to your YUMU assignments.

Click on "Hip Hop Lesson 5: Writing a Rap Chorus".

Click and watch Part1: Arriving - Will Smith - Summertime. What is this an example of?

Now listen to Part 2: Lyrics and Rapping -Rhyme. After you have watched the videos, answer the following questions:

- Which words make the assonance in the fourth line?
- What do you call two lines that rhyme and end with the same sound?

Now listen to Part 2: Your Planet 2022. After you have watched the videos, answer the following questions:

- What is the rap about?
- What type of rhyming does Max use?
- What is different about the lyrics of the chorus?

Now use Your Planet 2022 Rap the Gap to learn the chorus.

Today you need to think of a theme for today's rap chorus as you will need to write a 4 line rap chorus. You can loop Rap Backing (major key) or Rap Backing (minor key) by entering no. 4 lots of times. This will provide a backing track if you wish to have one and should also help you create lyrics to fit in time.

Extension

Once you have finished your composition, ask yourself if you have included any assonance. If you have not, then edit your lyrics so that it does. Remember to always review your lyrics and performance at the end so that it is catchy and in time with the beat.

Choir

If you are a member of the choir, don't forget to look in the choir area on Charanga. There will be new songs added that you can learn and sing along to that we may possibly perform in the future. Make sure the rehearsal and instrumentation buttons are shaded when listening to the song.
