<u>RE - Pentecost</u>

Pentecost is a Holy day when Christians celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit. This year Pentecost occurred on Sunday 31st May. Read Acts 2 verses 1-13 and watch the clip <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IqG_lvZhU-A</u> Talk about the different parts of the story:

- The disciples were praying
- They heard a strong wind and flames appeared on their heads
- The disciples received the Holy Spirit
- The disciples began to talk in many different languages
- The disciples told people about Jesus.

Next talk about how the disciples might be feeling e.g. scared, surprised, and excited. Have you ever felt these emotions? Give examples of when and why. Finally draw, cut out and decorate your own flame to remind you of the story. Include key words and emotions from the story.
