

Year 1 and Year 2

You will be watching a different part of the story each week. To start off, go to the link below and read about the characters and background to the story. There are some story questions which you will need to answer after watching the first episode of the story. If you click on any individual question, the answer will be revealed!

Go to the video screen, click on the arrow on the right and scroll to "Episode 1 of the story". Now watch the story and answer the story questions on the page. Once you have done that, click on the arrow on the left and scroll back and listen to Tutorial 1. Once you have done that, scroll forward through the other videos, listening and joining in on Song 1: 'I Love red' (vocal) and then Song 1: 'I love red' (backing).

Extension

Look at the 'Listening Music' video found below on the page. Click on the video which will play 'Cinderella's Waltz' by a Russian composer called Sergei Prokofiev. What do you imagine when you listen to the music? Can you imagine Cinderella dancing with the Prince at the ball? Now, try and draw a picture of what you can imagine and see.
