Once you have done that, scroll forward through the other videos, listening and joining in on Song 2: 'Wolfie Blues (vocal) and then Song 2: 'Wolfie Blues' (backing).

Look at the 'Listening Music' video found below on the page. Click on the video which will play an overture from the opera 'The Marriage of Figaro' written by an Austrian composer called Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.

Listen to the music which is played by an orchestra. What is the main loud instrument you can hear? Is it fast or slow? Can you pretend to play this instrument along to music?
