Go to the video screen, click and watch "Episode 6 of the story" followed by "Episode 7 of the story". Now answer the story questions on the page. Once you have done that, click on the arrow on the right and scroll forward and listen to Tutorial for Song 5. Then scroll through the other videos, listening and joining in on Song 5: 'Jimmy be good' (vocal) and then Song 5: 'Jimmy be good' (backing).
