Outlined below are a range of activities that you may want to follow as part of your home learning schedule. At school we will be following this same plan.

As you can see below, tasks should not be very long at all. We have included timings to give you an indication of how long could be spent on each task. This week will be international week so we will be focusing on learning about different places around the world.

For the maths activities we will continue to use the White Rose maths resources. These are based on the topics that we would have been covering in school at this time.
