Once you have done that, scroll forward through the other videos, listening and joining in on Song 6: 'What big eyes you've got!' (vocal) and then Song 6: 'What big eyes you've got! (backing).

Listen to the music which is played by different instruments - violins, a clarinet and oboe. Have you heard this music before? Sometimes it is played for a special occasion in a church.
