Activities for the week

Phonics

We are continuing our Phase I phonics which focuses on listening skills. Last week we did Aspect 2 and this week we will be working on Aspect 3.

Aspect 3 - General sound discrimination - body percussion

The aim of this aspect is to develop children's awareness of sounds and rhythms. Activities include singing songs and action rhymes, listening to music and developing a sounds vocabulary.

Please see the **Phonics Aspect 3 Activity sheet** for all the activities. There are 5 activities to be done across the week.

Maths

This week we are learning about the number four. Try and find the number four in your environment (clocks, car number plates, house numbers etc). Lots of things come in 4's (yoghurts tins of beans, cans of drink, boxes of cakes, kitkat sweets, wheels on car etc).
