Activities for the week

Reading


This week we are focussing on the Gingerbread man story.

Activity 1: Whilst reading the story ask "What do you think the gingerbread man should do to cross the river?" At the end of the story ask whether they agree with the ending or how they would have ended the story.

Activity 2: Practise retelling the story – try using some voice sounds that we looked at in our phonic sessions to create sounds to go with the story eg footsteps running and animal sounds. Try and use the repeated phrases in the story when retelling 'run run as fast as you can, you can't catch me I'm the gingerbread man'


Activity 3: Decorate a gingerbread man, describe what you have made for him (buttons, hat, coat) – you can bake, use playdough, draw round a cutter on paper or ask an adult to help you get a template.

This week we are looking at the Presentation story. Start by sharing that a presentation is a gift, a present.


Watch the Beginners Bible: Simeon and Anna meet Baby Jesus or you might like to read the Bible at home: Luke Chapter 2 verses 23-40.
