Dear Butterfly and Ladybird Class,

We are so pleased that you have all enjoyed the vet topic. This is shown in the fantastic work that you have done. It is obvious that you have learned such a lot about the types of vets, what they do and how the look after different kinds of animals.

We are going to carry on learning about people who help us this term and we will now focus on Fire Fighters. The main task for this week is to do an observational drawing of a fire engine and to label it. They are all at different stages of development and this is quite usual. Please make sure that the children try to draw the fire engine themselves and have a go at writing the labels. It is important that the children are encouraged to produce whatever they are able to. This is how they will gain in confidence to 'have a go' and to persevere.
