






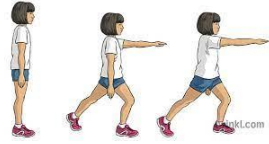
<p style="text-align: center;">Approximately 15 - 20 mins</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Choose one of your own story books or log into Reading Eggs and choose a book.</p> <p>We encourage children to look at the pictures in the book they are reading and always ask them to explain their ideas to us by talking in full sentences.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I think this story is about, because I can see a • Give children a little while to look at the front cover and ask them; <i>What do you think this story might be about?</i> Encourage them to explain their ideas using information they can see from the picture • Choose a child to point to the title. <i>How do you know that is the title?
