

St Edmund's Catholic Primary School Adult Questionnaires February 2022



My child is well looked after at this school 134 responses




My child is taught well at this school 134 responses





My child receives appropriate homework for their age 134 responses




6% of parents disagree that their children receive appropriate homework. This was from a mixture of parents with children in different year groups across the school. These views expressed either too much and/or too little homework. The aim of homework is to follow up what the children have been learning about in class but please do contact your child's class teacher if you have particular concerns that your child can't access their homework or if you would like more. The teachers will direct you to additional resources that you can use.

This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved 134 responses




94% of parents agree or strongly agree that the school makes sure pupils are well behaved whilst 4.5% don't know or have no experience of this. 1.5% and 0.7% (3 people) disagree that the children are well behaved. 1.5% were from parents of children in the early years who are learning to play within a bigger setting and the school have had follow up conversations with all those families to ensure their children are well supported at school.

This school deals effectively with bullying 134 responses




98% of families agree, strongly agree or have had no need to talk to the school about bullying. The school always seeks to deal with any form of bullying effectively and promptly and have followed up with the 2% of responses individually.

This school is well led and managed by staff and governors 134 responses




This school responds well to any concerns I may have 134 responses



99.3% of families feel the school responds well to their concerns or have no experience of needing a response. The 0.7% has been followed up – thank you for the inclusion of contact details.

I receive sufficient information about my child's progress 134 responses



8% of parents feel they do not receive enough information about their child's progress. We understand this and it has been difficult where results have not been published in 'Annual Reports' as a result of government recommendation. We are seeking to redress this for this academic year. Please take the opportunity to talk to your child's Class Teacher.

Would you recommend the school to another parent? 134 responses



The school have contacted the 3 parents who would not recommend our school to see how we could change this view.

Individual comments have been passed to children's class teachers or have been followed up by the Senior Leadership team. If you have any concerns at all please contact the school to enable us to help you and your child/ren.

Parents also made comments about clubs - not the variety of clubs on offer, rather the length of time of provision. Parents want child care until 6pm. At the moment we have no plans to further our after school on-site provision due to lack of space although are looking into what might be available for September 2022. We know this is an area that parents would like help with.
