SECONDARY TRANSFER – CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE

I have set aside some dates for parents/guardians to meet with me in order to have their children's forms signed to include with the applications to the Catholic Secondary Schools. Please fill in all the necessary information on the form(s) prior to your meeting as the time allocated is 5 minutes per child; as there will not be sufficient time to fill in the forms at the meeting.

You should make an appointment with the school office (not the parish office) for one of the following dates:

Monday 26th September 3.00pm to 5.30pm Wednesday 28th September 2.00pm to 4.30pm Tuesday 4th October 2.00 pm to 4.30 pm Thursday 6th October 2.00 pm to 4.30 pm

If you require copies of the Certificate of Catholic Practice please let the school office know when you book an appointment and they will send home copies via your child, also the CCP can be found on each secondary school website for you to download.

A Certificate of Catholic Practice is exactly what it says – it confirms, for the purposes of a Catholic School application, that a family are regular in their attendance at Mass, and so are practising Catholics. Certificates can be requested by Catholic and mixed families whose children are Baptised and who attend Sunday Mass. This is an important document, please do not embarrass the parish priest by requesting a certificate if you are not attending Mass at St Edmund's regularly. If you attend a different Catholic church you should apply there. If you happen to have recently moved into the area, then your previous parish priest can provide certification. Applications for children whose family are non-practising, or not Catholic, can still be made for Catholic schools without a certificate, and they will be considered under different admission criteria.

Applying

Children born between 1 September 2011 and 31 August 2012 are due to start year seven at secondary school in September 2023.

Use the eAdmissions website from 1 September to apply online for your child's secondary school place.

You can name up to six schools in your application including academy or free schools and schools in other council areas.

If you do not live in the borough, you need to apply through your own council and you can include Richmond schools in your application.

The closing date for applying for a year 7 place is 31 October 2022.

When making your application in eAdmissions you should:

- •Complete a separate application for each child if you are applying for twins or triplets
- •Applications should also be made to every school you are interested in applying to
- •Advise them in your application if your child will have a brother or sister (sibling) attending your preferred school(s) in September 2023
- •Consider how places were allocated at Richmond secondary schools in the last three years
- •Certain schools need additional information to apply their admissions criteria and may require you to also complete a Supplementary Information Form. For example, schools that prioritise applications by faith. If you are applying for this type of school, please check the school's website for further information and to download a Supplementary Information Form.

If your child has an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP), or a Statement of Special Education Needs, you don't need to complete the application.

Online

If you have applied online:

- •You will be sent an email during the evening of **1 March 2023** to tell you the outcome of your application. You will also be able to view this information by logging in to the eAdmissions website
- •If you applied online and your child did not qualify for a place at your first preference school, your outcome email will provide you with more information about the process and what to do next
- •If you applied online, use the eAdmissions website to tell us if you wish to accept or refuse the school place your child has been offered. The deadline to do this is **15 March 2023**. Submitting your response online, guarantees that the school knows your decision.

Paper

If you applied on a paper form:

- •If you applied on a paper form, you will be sent an email on **1 March 2023** with the outcome of your application
- •Please respond to the email by the deadline of **15 March 2023** to tell us if you wish to accept or refuse the school place your child has been offered. Returning your reply by the deadline guarantees the school knows your decision

Waiting list

Waiting list positions will be available from Thursday 30 March 2023.

Your right to appeal

You have a legal right to appeal against a decision not to offer your child a place at any or all of the schools that you've applied to. You can appeal for a place at your preferred school even though your child may have a place somewhere else.

The process

The admissions authority for the school you're applying to must explain why your child hasn't been offered a place at that school. They must also explain how you can appeal against this decision.

Your appeal will be heard by a panel which is independent of the school and the admissions authority whose decision you're appealing against. You've the right to attend the hearing to explain your case to the independent appeal panel.

There are strict rules around the appointment of the appeal panel members to ensure their impartiality and independence. The panel's decision has to be accepted by the admissions authority and the school.
